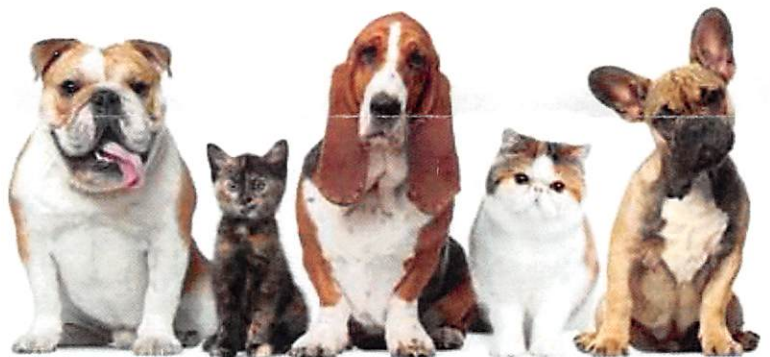

- Rabies vaccinations are required for **ALL** cats, dogs, and domesticated ferrets by **four** months of age (but not less than 12 weeks).
- Ferrets must be vaccinated **annually**.
- Cats and dogs are given a booster **one** year after their first vaccination and then every **three** years thereafter.

There is no charge, but donations are accepted to help defray costs.
